

Terms and Conditions for Equipment Shipment to worldwide (DAP)

1. Incoterms and Delivery Basis

All shipments are made under **DAP (Delivered At Place)** terms. This means the seller arranges and pays for transportation of the goods to the agreed delivery address in worldwide. Risk transfers to the buyer upon delivery.

2. Duties, Taxes, and Customs Charges

Under DAP terms, **the buyer is fully responsible for all import duties, taxes, VAT, customs clearance fees, and any related charges** upon entry into worldwide. These costs are not included in the seller's charges for transport or equipment.

3. Transport Method

Goods may be shipped via **groupage trailer, road freight, sea freight, or air freight**, depending on the destination and service availability.

4. Transit Time

Transit times vary depending on the destination, chosen freight method, customs clearance procedures, and carrier availability. All transit times are estimates only, and the seller is not liable for delays outside their control. The seller is not liable for delays outside their direct control.

5. Packaging and Condition of Goods

All equipment will be packaged to an appropriate standard for international road transport. The buyer must inspect the goods upon delivery and report any visible damage directly to the courier at the time of receipt.

6. Liability and Risk


Risk passes to the buyer once the goods have been delivered to the agreed address under DAP terms. The seller is not responsible for any delays, losses, or additional costs incurred during customs clearance or due to failure by the buyer to provide required import information.

7. Insurance

Insurance is not included unless specifically agreed in writing. If required, the buyer must request additional insurance coverage prior to shipment.

8. Documentation

All standard commercial documentation (commercial invoice, packing list, and transport

documentation) will be provided. Any additional documentation required for import must be requested by the buyer in advance.

9. Failed Delivery Attempts

If the courier is unable to deliver due to incorrect address details, lack of unloading capability, or the buyer’s unavailability, any redelivery, storage, or return costs will be charged to the buyer.

10. Governing Law

These terms and conditions are governed by the laws of England and Wales, unless otherwise agreed in writing.
